3 CORE COURSES: 110 Introduction to Psychology (prerequisite for most courses)

201 Statistical Methods in Psychology (prereg: 110)

301 Research Methods in Psychology (prereq: 201; no first-year students; formerly PSYCH 205)

AT LEAST 8 ADDITIONAL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES, including:

at least 2 from Column A (Row 1 or Row 2)

 at least 2 200-level courses at least 2 from Column B (Row 1 or Row 2) (may include COG SCI 210 and 211)

• at least 1 from Column C (Row 1 or Row 2) at least 3 300-level courses

at least 1 from Row 2

A course may count toward more than one of these requirements, but the total must be at least 8.

FIVE RELATED COURSES (required in addition to the above):

- a.) Two quantitative courses: EITHER two 200-level Mathematics courses OR one 200-level Mathematics course and one advanced Statistics course (STAT 232 or higher) AND
- b.) Three additional related courses chosen from the following: Mathematics at the 200-level; COG SCI 202 or 207; COMP SCI 110, 111, or 150; PHIL 327; STAT 232 or higher; all courses outside of psychology and cognitive science counting toward the WCAS Foundational Discipline Natural Sciences requirement. AP credits in Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, and Physics count toward this requirement. With permission, Psych 380 may count toward this requirement instead of as a psychology course.
