

**REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR IN PSYCHOLOGY**

**3 CORE COURSES:** 110 Introduction to Psychology (prerequisite for most courses)  
 201 Statistical Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 110*)  
 301 Research Methods in Psychology (*prereq: 201; no first-year students; formerly PSYCH 205*)

**AT LEAST 4 ADDITIONAL PSYCHOLOGY COURSES**, including:

- at least 1 from Column A below
- at least 1 from Column B below
- at least 1 200-level psychology course or COG SCI 210 or 211
- at least 2 300-level courses

**A course may count toward more than one of these requirements, but the total must be at least 4.**
