- ² Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.
- ³ Psych 205 with Dr. Hespos will break up into smaller discussion sections on Wednesdays. These will be at the same time as the Monday class meeting. Students must sign up for *both* the lecture and a discussion section.
- ⁴ Psych 303 will break up into smaller discussion sections on Fridays. Students must sign up for *both* the lectures (taking place on Tuesdays and Thursdays) and a Friday discussion section.
- ⁵ For 397 and 399, get an application from the department office. Fill it out, have it signed by the professor with whom you will work, and return it to the office to get a permission number. Permission numbers will be available beginning **Wednesday, February 16**. For 398, get a permission number from the department office; you must be on Prof. Uttal's list of eligible students.
