Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.

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For Psych 397 and 399, download an application from the department website. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office to receive permission to take the course. PSYCH 398-1,2,3 is sequential with 398-1 offered in Fall quarter, 398-2 in Winter, and 398-3 in Spring.
