Preregistration, Permission, and Other Enrollment Notes

<sup>2</sup> Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.

<sup>3</sup> For 397 and 399, get an application from the department office. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then take it to the department office and get a permission number. For 398, get a permission number from the department office; you must be on the list provided by the honors coordinator, Prof. Uttal.

<sup>4</sup> For 205-0-22 with *Sara Broaders*, sign up for both the Tues/Thurs and Thurs sections of the course. Effectively, it is only one class. All students meet together on Tuesday and the class splits into discussion sections on Thursday.

<sup>5</sup> To register for 218, you must also sign up for one of 4 discussion sections (Friday at 10am, 1pm, 2pm, and 3pm). The class meets Mon/Wed for lecture and splits into discussion sections on Fridays.
