² Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.

³ For 205 with Dr. Molden, sign up for the Mon/Wednesday lecture. Then you must pick a mandatory Friday discussion. The class meets all together on Mon/Wed and splits into discussion sections in computer labs on Fridays.

⁴ By department permission only. To be eligible for this class, you must be a freshman in Fall 2012 and have (a) earned a 4 or 5 on the AP Psychology exam and/or (b) completed Introduction to Psychology at a college or university from which Northwestern accepts credit.

⁵ For 397 and 399, get an application from the department office. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office and get a permission number. For 398, get a permission number from department office; you must be on the list prepared by the honors coordinator, Prof. Waxman.
