² Psychology and Cognitive Science majors and minors can preregister for most courses through CAESAR the week prior to registration. Times are announced by the Registrar's Office. You can preregister for a maximum of 2 courses.

³ For 205 with Prof. Richeson, sign up for the Tuesday lecture. Then you must pick a mandatory Thursday discussion section. The class meets all together on Tuesdays and will sometimes splits into two sections in computer labs on Thursdays.

⁴ By department permission only. To be eligible for this class, you must be a freshman in Fall 2013 and have (a) earned a 4 or 5 on the AP Psychology exam and/or (b) completed Introduction to Psychology at a college or university from which Northwestern accepts credit.

⁵ For 397 get an application from the department office. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office to receive permission to take the course. For 398, get permission from department office; you must be on the list prepared by the honors coordinator, Prof. Waxman.
