³ For 205 with Dr. Hespos, sign up for the Tuesday lecture. Then you must pick a mandatory Thursday discussion section. The class meets all together on Tuesdays and splits into two discussion sections in computer labs on Thursdays.

⁴ If you would like to take this class, please email Dr. Grabowecky at grabowecky@northwestern.edu. Tell her that you would like to be added to Psych 314-22 Hallucinations, and tell her what prerequisites you have taken. She will give Maria Candelario in the department office a list of students who can enroll, and Ms. Candelario will then email students once they have been granted permission on CAESAR to enroll.

⁵ For 397 and 399, get an application from the department office. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office to receive permission to take the course. For 398, get permission from department office; you must be on the list prepared by the honors coordinator, Prof. Waxman.
