<sup>3</sup> For Psych 397 and 399, download an application from the department website (you can find it [here](#)). Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office to receive permission to take the course. Psych 398-3 is consequential with 398-1 and 398-2, so students must have taken 398-1 and 398-2 to register for 398-3.
