³ For 205 with Prof. Miller, sign up for the Monday lecture. Then you must pick a mandatory Wednesday discussion section. The class meets all together on Mondays and will split into two sections in computer labs on Wednesdays.

⁴ For 397 and 399 get an application from the department office. Fill it out and have it signed by the professor with whom you will be working. Then return it to the department office to receive permission to take the course. For 398, get permission from department office; you must be on the list prepared by the honors coordinator, Prof. Waxman.
